Accommodation

In Barcelona, you will encounter several types of accommodation. Here are some of them to look out for:

Room. Rented flat is the most common form of accommodation for students in Barcelona, as the requirements to enter one of these situations are not as demanding as others.

Expect to pay between 500–700€, depending on neighbourhood, size of room and other factors, as well as bills. It is recommended to visit the place personally and talk to the owner before renting it.

Apartment. If you are with the means to rent an apartment on your own, or with someone else, you will find plenty of options, with prices ranging from 700–1200€ for a small apartment in Barcelona.

In order to rent a flat you usually must have a job contract and / or be ready to pay a several months' security deposit.

Student Residence. If you want to rent a short-term place to stay before traveling to Barcelona, a student residence is a good option. Prices for this can range from 600€ for a room and go right up! You also need to be aware of the rules of the residence, too. Keep in mind that the availability at the student residences varies depending on the student season.



Finding accommodation in Barcelona can be really challenging sometimes, so we have prepared a few options to make your search easier or be a temporary solution.

FreeDa collaborates with several student residences, such as Resa or Tagaste, and with student apartments from Barna Students Place. Rooms in both the residences and the apartments can be individual or double, with private or shared bathrooms.

The cost of such rooms ranges from 500–1000 €, and to the first payment is always necessary to add a deposit of 1 month.

The school also has a student apartment. We offer rooms for the first month of accommodation, in an apartment in the area of Poble Sec, next to the market Sant Antoni and the Parallel station. The apartment is 20 minutes walk from the school at Flassaders 7-9 and 30 minutes by public transport from the school in Gràcia.

Visa

To study and live in Spain or in the EU, you have to fulfill certain prerequisites of stay in the territory of the EU country. Many people are intimidated by the process of obtaining a visa: collection of documents, a visit to the Consulate and other procedures. But in fact it is not as hard as it may seem. The main thing is to carefully approach the entire process and be aware of some nuances.

All non-eu citizens need a visa to live, work and study in Spain. The visa must be applied through the Spanish Consulate in the country of residence or directly in Spain, and for this procedure you will need to gather a certain package of documents. At freedaspace.com, we give you a complete list of documents to submit. To change the **touristic status into a student** one, you must have a visa...



...valid for at least 30 days in the Schengen area.

There are **2 types of student visas: up to 180 days and from 180 days to one year.**

The maximum duration of the student visa is 1 year. However, you may extend it more than once without leaving Spain.

Our courses

We have courses to meet all your needs. From individual classes, fitting your schedule, to intensive courses which are designed to be compatible with your Student Visa.

General

10h / week. This is the main course that includes two hours of classes each day, so you can practise all the essential skills during these classes.

Combined

15h / week. This course includes the general 10h / week, plus an extra class: either an extra grammar class to build your base, or an extra speaking class to get you ready for the real world!

Intensive

20h / week. The most intensive mode you can choose for any level, from A1 to C2. It includes 2 hours of the main course, plus both a grammar class and an hour of speaking practice.

This course is the only one suitable for your student visa!

Individual classes

Help to deepen specific language skills according to the student's request. Also suitable for the intensive course students as extra classes.

Grammar / conversation

5h / week. This course is not recommended for the beginners but for those who already have B1 level or higher. You will have 1 hour daily to focus on your grammar OR your speaking skills.

Extensive

3 or 4.5h / week. The course consists of learning Spanish by the textbook as well as language practice at the school events. The program is aimed at those who already live in Spain and would like to combine studying and working full-time.
