1. Completed AEC Application (www.aec.edu/online-application)
2. Prepare Required Documents
 - Passport copy (*valid for at least 9 months*)
 - Recent Transcript or Diploma
 - Recent Bank Statement showing \$23,000-\$34,000+ (*for 12-18 month duration*)
 - *For Transfer Students Only:* Current I-20, Visa or COS Approval Notice
3. Application Fees
 - Application Fee (non-refundable): \$160
 - SEVIS I-901 + Processing Fee: \$385
 - DHL Overseas Delivery: \$125, additional cost may incur depending on country
 - Pathway Conditional Acceptance Letter: \$175
